To do immediatly

- Notify friends and family.

- *Medical Certificate of Death: is*sued by a physician or the Medical Examiner's office (free)
- Death Certificate: ordered through Service Alberta (charges will apply)
- Birth Certificate
- Driver's License
- Marriage Certificate
- Passport
- Personal Will
- Social Insurance Card (or Number)

Financial Documents

- Bank and Credit Cards
- Bank Account Numbers
- Bank Statements (Chequing, Saving, Line of Credit, etc.)
- Investment Records (bonds, stocks, RRSP, GIC's, etc.)
- Loan Agreements
- Mortgage Papers
- Lease and/or Rental Contracts
- Safety Deposit Box Number (if applicable)

Property Documents

- Land Titles
- Personal Possessions
- Vehicle Registration(s)

Health Documents

- Provincial Health Care Card or Number
